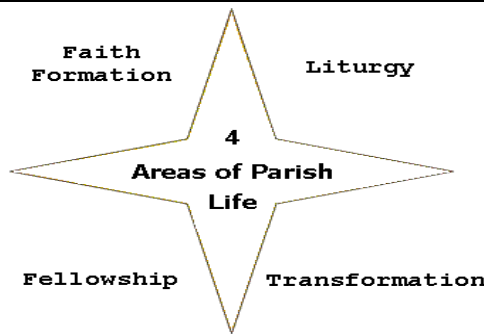

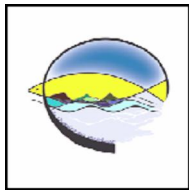
FAITH IS A GIFT FROM GOD
