Archbishop Durocher wrote the following message to the parishioners:

"I know this will come as a surprise to all of you. I realize some will be disappointed and others will be pleased. I would ask that you understand the reason for this abrupt change. Fr. Rooney has gone through a gruelling summer, losing first one brother and then a second to sudden heart attacks. Indeed his whole family has been enduring a terrible trial and many pieces need to be picked up. For Fr. Rooney, the additional stress of moving and taking up a new responsibility is proving more difficult than anticipated. His doctor worries that it could have a repercussion on his physical health which is fragile at this time. Following his doctor's advice, Fr. Rooney has therefore asked that his nomination to Aylmer be cancelled to allow him to deal with this extremely difficult personal situation."

"As bishop, I must seek to balance the health of the parishes and the health of the priests who serve our diocese. I believe my decision to be the best possible in the present circumstances. As Saint Paul says, we who minister to God's people carry a treasure "in earthen vessels" which can easily be cracked and broken. I therefore ask all of you to join me in praying for your priests, in supporting them, in caring for them as they endeavour to minister to the best of their abilities. May God help us all to move forward as communities of faith, hope and love."
