

WE ARE BACK IN ORDINARY TIME

Now we are back into Ordinary Time, as it is called in Church language. It is very much as in life itself; we have our high and low points, and a lot of grey and ordinary areas in between. In all of it, Jesus Christ is the one who leads the way for us and in whom God graces us.

CELEBRATING THIS EXPERIENCE IN EUCHARIST TODAY...

The eucharistic liturgy has a number of "beginnings," moments that combine to establish our worship experience. It starts long before we arrive at the church, and goes back to our decision to respond to God's call in the first place. Then, each week we choose to attend the liturgy, prepare ourselves, and travel there.

When we arrive we bless ourselves with water to recall our new spiritual life through baptism. The Penitential Rite allows us to acknowledge our sins and experience God's forgiveness. We listen to the scriptures, expecting God to speak to us anew, and the homily helps apply that word to our experience today.

At the core of the liturgy is the eucharist itself. The greatest beginning in history is Jesus becoming one of us, which we celebrate through the transformation of the bread and wine into his body and blood. Then we receive that food in order to be nourished in body and spirit. This union with Christ, and through him, with each other, renews us to live our lives as a sign of God's renewed relationship with the world.
