

#### La Table de Bethlehem

At a recent Transformation Committee meeting, it was decided to respond to an August article in Le Bulletin, an appeal to the community to assist our local "soup kitchen" for school-aged children called La Table de Bethlehem. The Committee members decided to forward this appeal to our two parishes and make this our Thanksgiving project.

For the next two (2) weekends, we ask parishioners to respond to this appeal by providing any of the following items:

- Canned goods: veggies such as corn, sauces, fruit
- Soda crackers
- Juices (Oasis)
- Baking goods: flour, baking soda, baking powder
- Pasta (bows or macaroni)

La Table de Bethlehem prepares healthy meals with the freshest ingredients possible. They purchase fruits, vegetables and meat from local markets on a regular basis. Consequently, there is always a need for money to make these purchases. All monetary donations will be gratefully accepted.

Following this special Thanksgiving collection, all the non-perishables received at both parishes will continue to be distributed to our local food bank, La Mie de l'entraide.
