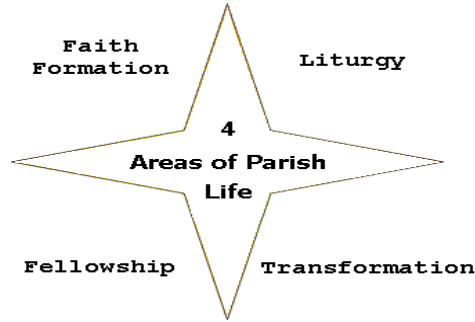

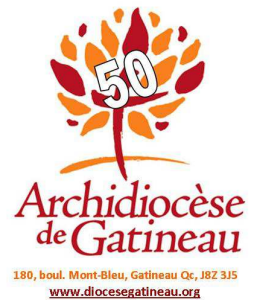

Sunday, November 23, 2014 – As a member of my Christian community, I think about a project we can do locally to present bullying.

Christ the King – The End of the Liturgical Year

This Sunday we finally arrive where Matthew's gospel with all its parables about the kingdom and all its conflicts between Jesus and Jewish authorities has been leading us.

Early in Ordinary Time, we heard how blessed we are, from Jesus' Sermon on the Mount. At that time, we were beginning our journey of faithful discipleship. Now, we come to the end and hear once again how blessed we are. Matthew shows us in the course of his gospel (and our proclaiming it throughout the year) a microcosm of what, in fact, our whole Christian life is all about.

We begin with the blessing of baptismal waters, and we end with judgement and eternal glory.

The Advent Season Begins Next Sunday

The word “**Advent**” derives from the Latin word that means “**coming or arrival.**” The Liturgy Committee has met with the Inter-Parish Planning Committee to organize our various Advent activities.
