THE ARCHBISHOP'S MONTHLY PRAYER INTENTIONS: AUGUST 2016

"That Christians may live the requirements of the Gospel by bearing witness to faith, honesty and love for their neighbour."

Social reflection: In our society, many people act in the interest of the common good by helping the widow and the orphan. They act in the name of humanism, either because of their religious values, or their Christian upbringing. In every field women and men work together to humanize society. In the Outaouais region, we need only to think of activist Bill Clennett, who devotes his life to defending the social rights of the poor; François Roy, coordinator of the Logemen' occupe organization, who fights for affordable housing for low-revenue families; in Quebec City, auxiliary nurse Gilles Kèglewho helps people in need. How can the example of these people help us to move forward as Christians?

<u>Answering our faith:</u> The best way to transmit our faith is to "always be ready to bear witness to the hope that is in you" (cf 1 P 3, 15). The Christian faith and the Evangelical values invite us to help our neighbour: just think of the parable of the Good Samaritan, of the Final Judgment, and of the line 'Love your enemies'. Also, history has given us many witnesses who have taught us to help our neighbours: St. Francis of Assisi, Bishop Romero, Jean Vanier, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., etc. Our actions are often more significant than our words. So, ourselves, are we ready to bear witness to this hope that inhabits us? If so, how shall we do it?

<u>Questioning ourselves: Sunday, August 7, 2016</u>: This week, I reflect on how I can be of service to my neighbour, in the name of my faith.

Sunday, August 14, 2016: Am I able to take a position for social justice in the name of my faith at the risk of being criticized?

A short prayer for a safe journey to all our travellers:

"Lord, be our guide and our protector on the journey we are about to take. Watch over us. Protect us from accidents. Keep us free from harm to body and soul. Lord, support us with Your grace when we are tired. Help us be patient in any trouble which may come our way.

Keep us always mindful of Your presence and love. Amen."
