**Let's keep calling for due diligence to put *People and Planet First!***

Development and Peace's ***People and Planet First*** campaign is calling on Canada to prevent its corporations from abusing human rights and the environment in their overseas operations and global supply chains.

Since September 2021, over 24,000 people have signed a petition calling for Canadian due diligence legislation and 38 meetings were held with members of Parliament (46 parishioners of Our Lady of Victory and St. Malachy signed the petition).
