

# 4th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



First Reading: Zephaniah 2.3; 3.12-13

Responsorial Psalm: Blessed are the poor in spirit; the kingdom of heaven is theirs!

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 1.26-31

Gospel: Matthew 5.1-12

Each of the "blessed" is a statement about something important in the Christian life. They are an ideal of how to live and how to find God close to us.

The next gathering is scheduled for Sunday, February 5<sup>th</sup> and we have invited Just Equipping to join us. Just Equipping is the organization, under the leadership of Pierre and Judy Allard, who rents space in our Rectory. This organization is a Canadian Registered Charity committed to educating, training and equipping in the area of restorative justice – since 2006, a number of training missions have taken place in Africa. Pierre and Judy will provide an overview of the organization and some of their successful projects.
