Policy for the Protection of Children and Vulnerable Persons in the Archdiocese of Gatineau

For the sake of the little ones (Pr 31:9) ...protect minors and vulnerable adults

A few weeks ago, parishioners were advised that the diocese was implementing a new policy. The following is an update from the Diocesan Coordinator:

Hello everyone, I have just about completed visits of each French and English parish, presenting the Diocesan Guide for the implementation of measures to make our parishes safe for minors and vulnerable persons, and to protect them from other types of harm (theft, fraud, breach of confidentiality, harassment, etc.). These meetings also allowed for the presentation of concrete tools for putting these safety measures in place.

Just a reminder that this project is a diocesan priority and is compulsory, affecting both volunteers and paid staff, including priests.

As a Christian community we can be proud, to finally make this significant change, assuring all parishioners served by their parish, whether young, old, or vulnerable, that they can feel (fully) secure.
