

# ASCENSION OF THE LORD (World Communication Day)

First Reading: Acts 1.1-11

Responsorial Psalm: God has gone up with a shout, the Lord with the sound of a trumpet

Second Reading: Ephesians 1.17-23
Gospel: Mathew 28.16-20

A man went one starry night and shook his fist at the heavens yelling, "Oh God what a lousy, rotten world you have made. I could have done much better." Then a voice boomed from the clouds saying "That is why I put you there. Get busy."

#### Policy for the Protection of Children and Vulnerable Persons in the Archdiocese of Gatineau

For the sake of the little ones (Pr 31:9) ...protect minors and vulnerable adults

(The following item is further to the Diocesan message that was published in the parish bulletin of April 22-23, 2023)

The second value in the Code of ethics: Autonomy and Self determination.

No matter where we come from, how we were brought up, or what we are capable of, each one of us has the right to express themselves, to make their own choices, to act and think for themselves. This is what the value of autonomy and selfdetermination in our Code of ethics means. Encourage your peers to express themselves and discuss their opinions. It is not always easy to accept having our ideas questioned by people whose opinions or experiences are different from our own. Of course, this needs to be done respectfully, that is, in consideration of others' existence, ideas, and opinions. Maintaining prejudices, violating the right to speak, seeking to control others are just some examples of not living up to this value. "Love one another with mutual affection" (Romans 12:10).

With the people we serve and in our relationships with volunteers and employees, let's encourage one another to express ourselves and share our points of view. Still to come, our third value.
