

MOROCCO EARTHQUAKE: HELP NEEDED RIGHT NOW

Development and Peace — **Caritas Canada** is collecting funds to support rescue and relief efforts in Morocco, after the country was hit by its most powerful earthquake in a century. A magnitude 6.8 earthquake struck in Morocco's High Atlas Mountains, 72 kilometres southwest of the city of Marrakesh. Media reports put the death toll past 2,800. These grim numbers are likely to rise dramatically.

In a telegram sent on his behalf by the Cardinal Secretary of State, Pope Francis expressed "his profound solidarity with those who are touched in their flesh and heart by this tragedy" and prayed "for the repose of the dead, the healing of the injured and the consolation of those who mourn the loss of their loved ones and their homes."

Development and Peace — **Caritas Canada** is establishing contact with organizations in the region, including Caritas Morocco. The wider Caritas Internationalis network, too, is mobilizing to help as necessary. From responding to many such natural disasters, we know that in addition to meeting great and urgent immediate needs, it is always necessary to invest in longer-term recovery and resilience-building efforts. Both of these forms of aid require and rely on the generosity of Canadians, which has always been forthcoming.
