## **FATHER GREG'S LENTEN MESSAGE**

*"This is my Son, my Chosen; listen to him!"*

'Listen'. How many times have we heard that prayer – one of the recommended practices of the season of Lent – is not so much about speaking as it is about listening. I don't possess truth, but God does; who would you rather listen to?

'Listen'. Read the scriptures, God has spoken through them from the beginning. Look at the things that happen to you from day to day, especially those things when seem to run contrary to your desires. What is God saying? Listen to the people around you, listen to the warnings and also to the praise of others. What does it all mean? Go to the source of meaning to find out.

When you pray, say what you need to say in as few words as possible, and then listen to the silence, listen for a word, and then meditate upon it. If nothing comes, so be it. Listen anyways. But, most importantly, look at Jesus, at what he did and said, and imitate him. God will speak to you through him.
