The bishop of our diocese has asked our parish to organize a celebration for the Feast of the Sacred Heart **on Friday, June 27<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m.** **This celebration will be held at St. Aloysius.** This celebration is meant, not only to recognize this important feast day, but also to acknowledge the presence of the Congregation of the Priests of the Sacred Heart in the life of this diocese. Especially the long-time ministry of Fr. Bill Marreeve, SCJ.

### WHY MOBILIZE AROUND THE G7?

As part of the **Turn Debt into Hope** campaign, we are mobilizing Canadians and the world on the issue of debt justice. The G7 summit will be held under Canada's presidency in Kananaskis, Alberta from June 15<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup>. It is a key moment to urge decision-makers to prioritize people and the planet over mere profit and to demand debt justice for communities crushed by unjust and unpayable debts.

Our advocacy resulted in these demands being incorporated into the Civil 7 Communiqué 2025. The Civil 7, coordinated this year by Cooperation Canada, is an official engagement group that communicates civil society priorities and recommendations to G7 leaders.
