

3rd Sunday of Advent A

When the birth of a child draws near, we are joyful and happy: Gaudete Sunday! This Sunday in Advent marks the shift from the more penitential tone of the last two weeks to the joyful anticipation of the historical birth of Jesus Christ our Lord. We are joyful because our salvation is drawing so near. There is a parallel in Lent, midseason, when we also express our happiness: Laetare Sunday. We are joyful then because salvation will come to us through the death and resurrection of Jesus: the reason for his birth! Rejoice in the Lord always, I say it again, rejoice, says St. Paul!


