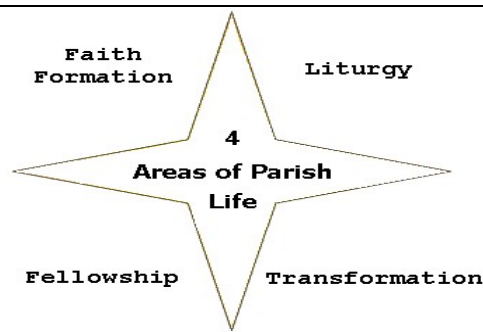

FATHER JOHN’S MESSAGE

Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time A

Did you know that the words *A Mari Usque Ad Mare (From Sea to Sea)* is written on the Canadian coat of arms (also called the Royal Coat of Arms of Canada). The phrase is taken from the Latin text of Psalm 72:8 but also occurs in our first reading today. It expresses the dominion of God across the earth. This powerful force or dominion is also given to us in baptism so that we may subdue our unruly flesh. It is the Spirit of Christ who puts to death the sinful deeds and of our body and spirit. Dominion over our own unruly spirits and body is a prerequisite for that Gospel peace that gives us rest and humility of heart.

CHANGES TO SATURDAY MASS IN MAYO FROM MAY 2nd TO OCTOBER 3rd

This **SUMMER** from May 2nd to October 3rd inclusive, on the **FIRST Saturday a month only**, Mass will **NOT** be celebrated at St. Malachy's. **These days correspond to the First Saturdays: May 2, June 6, September 5 and October 3.** Instead on these first Saturdays, in place of Mass, there will be a Liturgy of the Word/Communion Service at 5pm. *Those parishioners in Mayo who wish to attend Mass, may do so at Our Lady of Victory Parish, twenty minutes away in Buckingham, on the Sunday following at 9 am. There are two exceptions to this change occurring on July 11th and August 8th. AFTER October 3rd, Mass will once again be celebrated at St. Malachy's on Saturday at 5pm. The Liturgy of the Word/Communion Service does fulfill your Sunday obligation, if you are living in Mayo. Thank you! Fr. John*

VENEZUELA EARTHQUAKES – YOUR HELP IS NEEDED NOW

Our partner **Caritas Venezuela** is already providing emergency aid to earthquake survivors, but because of the scale of the disaster, they need your help urgently! Last week's earthquakes, the worst in over a century, have taken 1,450 lives and left some 50,000 people unaccounted for. The final toll is expected to be much higher. Through its vast diocesan network, Caritas Venezuela is working round-the-clock to provide food, water, medicine, hygiene kits, clothing, essential supplies, psychosocial support and pastoral care, prioritizing the elderly, children, pregnant women and persons with disabilities.

To facilitate this work, **Development and Peace - Caritas Canada** has made an initial allocation of \$50,000. Praying for the victims and encouraging those helping them, Pope Leo XIV has sent a €100,000 donation. Now, we are calling Canadians to step up.

Caritas Venezuela is better equipped than many other organizations to reach the most vulnerable people in the farthest corners. Please give generously to help them serve the quake-affected Venezuelan people.

A SUMMARY OF THE COMMUNICATION FROM THE BISHOP

It is important to refresh our understanding of the way in which we interact with the gift of the Eucharist. Please remember that the most Holy Eucharist may not be reserved in a private home without the legitimate authorization of the competent ecclesiastical authority. This usually means the bishop.

When **bringing Holy Communion to a sick or homebound person**, in order to respect the dignity of the One whom we are carrying, the Eucharist must be carried in a proper pyx. Any other means such as a handkerchief, paper napkin, or any other unsuitable container is not appropriate or permissible.

If you are **someone who routinely carries the Eucharist to shut-ins**, please contact the pastor for a spare pyx. Thank you for giving due reverence to Him who has made himself so available to us journeying home. *Fr. John*
