- Furnace Update
- low water detector has been ordered and will be changed
- Ken to get estimate on a 2 stage burner to save fuel.
- Shed Door Ordered from Potvin a garage style door. (approx cost \$1, 173.57)

- **Door ladies washroom** does not close properly (may have to be shaved to fit better). If still trouble locking install a latch. Phil to request Dan to take care of this.
- **Toilets in Basement Washrooms** Susan will ask Andrew to take a look at them. Then determine what has to be done.

Paper towel holder in men's washroom (no door) – look into fixing or replacing this.

We will look at the safety bars to be installed. Lyall will look for fixing.

- Fencing on Joseph St. Look at a fundraiser to pay for this. We could look at the fences sold in sections. Will have to look at the survey to check the line. We would also have to check with BELL CANADA as there is a box near the line.
- Fence on Church Street Cemetery we may have to replace the posts and put in boards across or go with post and rails again. Susan will have Junior take a look and see what is needed.
- Lighting for stairwells to basement get an estimate from DUBUC to see what could be done to provide more light down the stairs. Could use existing fixtures at the entrance of the church and put a directional light which could point down the stairwells.
- **3. Parking** Bill proved information from the Ville de Gatineau website regarding parking permits and the associated costs. We may look at least getting 2 permits (Dan and Margaret) Alma uses the driveway of the house.

There is still a problem with people parking on the walkway to the church.
