	 1. Archbishop Visit The archbishop – Paul Andre Durochers will be visiting all parishes within the diocese. He has scheduled March 10th for OLV and St. Malachy. We will work with St. Malachy representatives to organize the day: Starting in the morning: meet wardens, meet members of other commities (liturgy, transformation, OLV Society, faith formation etc.) Celebration of mass (OLV on Sunday) at 11:00 a.m. We will look at providing lunch and possibly supper as there is a possibility to have a meditation/reflection time in the evening with the Archbishop.
