	- windows in connector room We will look at replacing these windows in the near future. The caulking around them was done in the fall, but they do not have much insulation around them and are not very energy efficient.	
	- eaves troughs The bingo room still has a bit of water that is coming in. We were not advised in the spring if any water was coming in near the janitor closet/area near the conference room. We are still looking at building up the soil in the corners so that the water flows away from these corners.	
	Lyall will put back the extensions at the end of the down spouts in the front near the connector room and at the back of the church near the sacristy.	
	- fire alarms We will look at our fire alarm systems that are in the church, church hall and house and do an annual test.	
	- Electrical wires - contact Hydro Quebec The main electrical wire leading from the back of the house to the main pole looks old and it appears that the outer protective coating is cracking. Bill will contact Hydro Quebec and look into how the wire can be replaced.
